

Privacy and Cookie Policy National Chamber of Young Fashion Designers

This section contains information on how the data of users of the camerafashiondesigner.it website are managed and processed according to when Article 13 of EU Regulation no. 679/2016, on the protection natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and rules relating to the free movement of such data, requires. The policy may be subject to change due to changes in the management of personal data or due to the introduction of regulatory changes, therefore, the user is invited to periodically check the dedicated section.

Controller

The legislation defines "controller" as the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data. With regard to this website, the controller is the Association: "National Chamber of Young Fashion Designers", abbreviated as "**CNGFD*** CF 96012350839, P.IVA with headquarters in **Via Angelo Bagnoni, 78 - 00153 Rome**.

Place of data processing

Processing related to the web services of this site takes place at the headquarters of the owner and/or at the offices of service providers, allocated in the EU territory.

Type of data collected

Below is a brief description of the personal data provided directly or indirectly, through navigation on the site.

Browsing data

The computer systems and management software of the website acquire, in the course of their normal operation, some personal data whose communication is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

This category of data includes IP addresses or domain names of computers and terminals used by users, addresses in URI/URL (Uniform Resource Identifier/Locator) of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the

response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters related to the operating system and the computer environment of the user.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed for the purpose of:

- obtain statistical information on the use of the services (most visited pages, number of visitors per time slot or daily, geographical areas of origin, etc.).
- check the proper functioning of the services offered.

Data voluntarily communicated by the User

In some areas of the site, personal data of users may be collected as a result of the optional, explicit and voluntary sending of personal information by those who decide to send e-mails to the addresses indicated on the site.

The formulation of requests involves the necessary acquisition of the sender's address and additional information provided by the sender, necessary to carry out the planned activities and to respond to the requests made.

The information acquired is represented, therefore, by the identification data provided and any content included in the communication.

Users, in addition, may provide personal data in order to participate in the initiatives and institutional activities of the CNGFD. Such processing will from time to time be the subject of specific disclosures.

COOKIES

Type of cookies

The site uses cookies to make the user's browsing experience easier and more intuitive: cookies are small text strings used to store certain information that may relate to the user, his or her preferences or internet access device (computer, tablet or cell phone) and are mainly used to adapt the operation of the site to the user's expectations, offering a more personalized browsing experience by storing the choices made previously.

A cookie consists of a small set of data transferred to the user's browser from a web server and can only be read by the server that made the transfer. It is not executable code and does not transmit viruses.

Cookies do not record any personal information and any identifiable data will not be stored. If you wish, you can prevent some or all cookies from being saved. However, in this case your use of the site and its services may be impaired. To proceed without changing your options regarding cookies, simply continue browsing.

The type of cookies the site makes use of is technical.

a) Technical cookies

There are numerous technologies used to store information on the user's computer, which is then collected by other sites. Of these, the best known and most widely used is HTML. They are used for navigation and to facilitate the user's access to and enjoyment of the site. They are necessary for the transmission of communications over electronic networks or for the provider to deliver the service requested by the customer.

The settings to manage or disable COOKIES may vary depending on the Internet browser used. In any case, the user can manage or request the general deactivation or deletion of cookies by changing the settings of their internet browser.

Such deactivation may slow down or prevent access to certain parts of the site.

The use of technical cookies enables the safe and efficient use of the site.

From the point of view of duration, one can distinguish temporary session cookies that are automatically deleted at the end of the browsing session and are used to identify the user and thus avoid logging in each page visited and permanent ones that remain active in the po until they expire or are deleted by the user.

They are not stored persistently but exclusively for the duration of browsing until the browser is closed and vanish when the browser is closed. Their use is strictly limited to the transmission of session identifiers consisting of server-generated random numbers necessary to enable the safe and efficient exploration of the site.

The technical (session and first-party analytical) cookies in use on the Site are:

b) Third-party cookies

Third-party cookies are set by a website other than the one the user is visiting and reside on servers other than the visited website. Therefore, the use of data collected by these third-party operators via cookies is subject to their respective privacy policies.

Social Network Plugins

Categories of recipients

The data subject's personal data may be disclosed to :

- collaborators and employees of the Owner specifically authorized, within the scope of their respective duties.
- suppliers of the services offered through the Site or related to its operation.

Under no circumstances does the Data Controller transfer personal data to third countries or international organizations. However, it should be noted that transfer to non-European countries could take place through Social platforms (Facebook, Instagram, Youtube) as part of their own services.

Therefore, it is recommended to thoroughly review the terms and conditions of service of these platforms.

Rights of the data subject

As a user of CNGFD's website, you have the right to request :

- Confirmation as to whether or not data relating to you is being processed and to obtain access to your personal data in accordance with Article 15 of the GDPR.
- The rectification of ~~their~~ your personal data that is inaccurate and the integration of incomplete data.
- The right to erasure of their data, except for those contained in records that must be mandatorily retained by the confederation and unless there is an overriding legitimate reason to proceed with the processing.
- the restriction of processing where one of the cases referred to in Article 18 of the GDPR applies.
- objection to the processing of one's personal data, unless compelling legitimate reasons prevail over the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject.

- data portability, provided in the case of a contractual basis for processing, will consist only in the availability of the data submitted by you and processed informatically.
- Withdraw your consent.

The user has, in addition, the right to propose in accordance with Article 77 of EU Regulation 679/2016 a complaint to the Guarantor for the Protection of Personal Data, as the authority in charge of controlling the processing in the Italian State.
